Total 2019 Budget \$300,000

Highlights:

Protective Services \$60,000 – This includes fire protection services, First Response training, animal control and 911 dispatch services. 911 calls are charged to GIFN at \$750 per call, from the dispatch centre. GIFN also has a fire protection agreement with the Town of Georgina.

Road Maintenance \$60,000 – In addition to regular road maintenance, the Bear Road improvement project began in 2018. In 2019, the Bear Road project will be completed, and improvements will be made to Loon Road.

Garbage, Recycling and Landfill Collection \$50,000 – This includes weekly garbage and recycling collection as well as landfill operations and hauling of recycling materials to the mainland.

Environment Protection Services \$18,715 – This includes water quality monitoring, invasive species, species at risk, and opposition to the Upper York Sewage System.

Tax Administration \$30,000 – This includes costs of the tax administrator, tax administration software, and electronic banking fees.

MPAC Assessments \$30,000 – This represents a portion of the costs of the contract with MPAC to conduct the initial property assessments for the Georgina Island Tax District. This cost is expected to decrease in future years.
