Aazhaawe Deck Hand Trainee

Reports To: Aazhaawe Driver

Classification: Training to become a casual (fill-in) employee only after completion of training

General Description of Duties:

- Operate, maintain and repair deck equipment
- Assist ship engineers in performing routine maintenance work and repair to ship's engine, machinery and auxiliary equipment
- Monitor engine, machinery and equipment indicators, record variables and report abnormalities to ship engineer officer on watch
- Operate and maintain off-loading equipment
- Handle mooring lines, and splice and repair ropes, wire cables and cordage
- Review the vessel and ensure cleanliness and safety standards are maintained
- Clean, chip and paint deck surfaces as required

Qualifications:

- Must complete a medical for Transport Canada prior to starting the training
- Must be willing to travel and stay at the location of the Deck Hand training course for a period of between 20 to 27 days consecutively. Training involves the following courses
 - a) Marine Basic First Aid
 - b) STCW Basic Safety
 - c) STCW Survival Craft
 - d) Restricted Operator's Certificate - Maritime Commercial (ROC-MC)
(Details of the Courses are available on the Transport Canada Website)
- Must show the capability to complete all aspects of a training course once they have started
- Must be able to complete all testing to Transport Canada Standards as required
